

CONTEXT STATEMENT: BCDS (2020)

Booleroo Centre District School caters for R-12 students. It is situated 265kms from the Adelaide CBD. The enrolment in 2020 is 172 students. Enrolment at the time of the previous review was 207. The local partnership of schools is the Flinders Partnership. The school is also an active member of an alliance called the Mid North School's Education Co-operative (MNSEC).

The most recent Index of Community Socio-Economic Advantage score (ICSEA, 2018) was 1004 and is classified as Category 6 on the Department for Education Index of Educational Disadvantage.

The school population includes 2.34% Aboriginal students, 5.85% students with disabilities, 1.17% students with English as an additional language or dialect (EALD) background, 0% children/young people in care and 30% of students have currently been approved for School Card assistance.

The school leadership team consists of a principal in the second year of their first tenure, a senior leader pedagogy, numeracy & operations, a senior-leader reporting and student well-being, and a co-ordinator secondary pathways and literacy.

There are 16 FTE teachers including 0 in the early years of their career and 10 Step 9 teachers.
