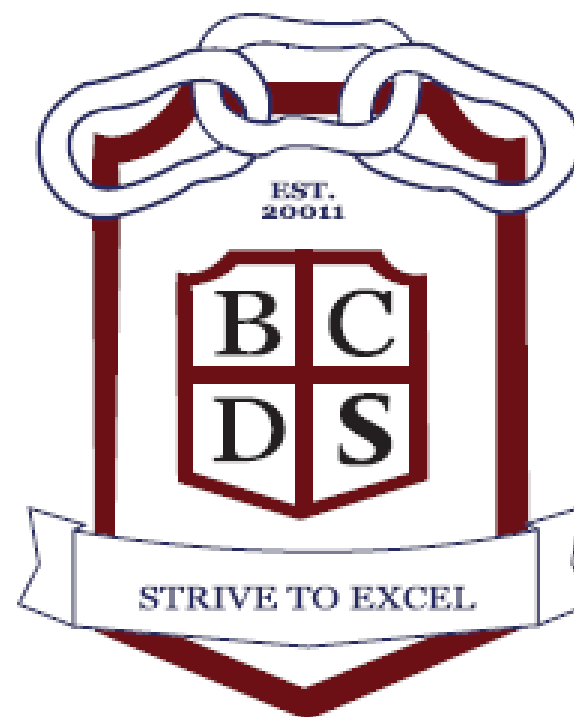

Improve student achievement in junior secondary school writing.	For those students enrolled in Year 8 in 2019, 70% will achieve a C or better on common moderated writing task.	If we prioritise the use multiple measures of assessment overtime (NAPLAN, PAT and Brightpath), incorporating strategies for scaffolding writing development into all curriculum areas. For example: upskilling teachers in writing, including: grammar and punctuation, spelling, reading, text types, editing and common language as well as subject specific language and writing requirements. We will increase student achievement in writing.
	For those students enrolled in Year 8 in 2019, 80% will achieve a C or better on common moderated writing task and SEA in NAPLAN Writing.
